






Despacio Abajo






Problem Solving






About Salsa Music

Señor Opuesto is performed in a popular dance music style called "salsa". The roots of salsa can be traced back to the early 1900's in Eastern Cuba but was later popularized by Cubans and Puerto Rican's living in New York City. Today, salsa remains as the most popular style of dance music within Hispanic countries and communities. Some of salsa's pioneers include Celia Cruz (Cuba), Willie Colón ("Nuyorican"), Rubén Blades (Panama), Joe Arroyo (Colombia) and many more.


Dancing Salsa
